STAFF ASSOCIATION MEETING NOVEMBER 3, 2009

The meeting was called to order by Sherry Stotesberry at 3:00 p.m.

Treasurer, Brown McFadden gave the treasurer's report. He stated that we now have \$839.11 in our checking account. Our savings account is showing a balance of \$289.61. Paid members stand at 30.

OLD BUSINESS

The Staff Association Christmas Social was discussed. It was noted that the SGA will hold a Christmas event on Tuesday December 8th at Noon, and the Campus Christmas Luncheon is scheduled for December 17th. A motion to set our social on Thursday December 10th at Noon. We will invite all paid staff association members to attend a covered dish lunch and to bring a wrapped present value to be less than \$5 for a gift exchange as we did last year.

Secret Santa - Staff association will again sponsor a "Secret Santa", an email will be sent out in early December with the recognition of your secret Santa at the Staff Association Christ Social.

Poinsettias – We have been advised that the Faculty Association can only provide \$75 this year. This is about half of the normal cost. Pauline Godley has researched the costs and reported that Lowes can provide 45 of the 6" plants for \$3.98 and if we place the order by November 20th we can get an additional 20% savings. At this price it will cost \$143.28 plus tax. A motion by Betsey Lee Hodges and second by Jo Linda Cooper to match the Faculty Association donation was made and carried by a vote of the members present.

SGA Challenge – The Student Government Association has challenged us to Ring Bells for the Salvation Army again this year. The project was discussed and a motion by Betsey Lee Hodges, seconded by Sarah Wallace to Ring Bells for the Salvation Army at Belks on Saturday December 5th from 10-8pm was made and carried by a vote of the membership.

Other Christmas Projects – The floor was opened for other projects. Sandy McFadden suggested a Can Food Drive to benefit the Zion Shelter. A motion by Sandy McFadden and seconded by Melvin Lodge was made and carried by the association. Details will be emailed next week.

Blog/Wiki – was discussed. Brown McFadden reported that a new software program is running on campus called WordPress. This is a blog, and offers the major features the association is looking for. Once concern brought up was to appoint a contact to post materials to insure that only appropriate content is posted, and that a "public" area open to the campus but also a "private" area accessible by Staff Association members would be present. A demonstration will be setup for the members to review. Heather Greer has agreed to be wiki master.

NEW BUSINESS

Raffle Tickets as a fund raiser and offering members the option to opt out by purchasing "insurance" was discussed. A motion by Betsey Lee Hodges and seconded by Romance Slade to hold a "ham and turkey" raffle for presentation before the Thanksgiving Holiday was made and carried by vote of the members present. Margie Cobb has created a template for the tickets and the tickets will be printed and issued to members this week. Members will be given the option to purchase insurance for \$10 so they don't have to sell tickets.
