## **CURRICULUM COMMITTEE**

# Minutes May 5, 2011

The Curriculum Committee met on Thursday, May 5, 2011, at 2:00 p.m., in the Conference Room of Building 1. Wesley Beddard, Dixon Boyles, Donna Dunn, Dell Enecks, Camille Richardson, Harold Smith, and Bryan Van Gyzen were present. Clay Carter, Laura Gipson, and Kim Moulden were absent. Chairman Wesley Beddard called the meeting to order and addressed the agenda as follows.

#### I. New Business

#### Arts and Science

Dixon Boyles made a motion to add the following courses to the BCCC Catalog:BIO 155-Nutrition, HIS 115-Introduction to Global History, HIS 145-The Second World War and PHI 240-Introduction to Ethics. The addition of these courses will be *effective Fall Semester 2011*. Dell Enecks seconded the motion. The motion carried.

#### **Business**

Donna Dunn presented the following items for approval:

- Modify Criminal Justice Technology (A55180) AAS degree so that SOC 210-Introduction to Sociology, SOC 220-Social Problems, or SOC 225-Social Diversity can be substituted for POL 130-State and Local Government. These changes to be effective Fall Semester 2011.
- Modify the Computer Information Technology (A25260) AAS degree. Delete NET 225-Routing & Switching I as an allowable substitute for NOS 120-Linux/UNIX Single User. In addition, delete NET 226-Routing & Switching II as an allowable substitute for WEB 140-Web Development Tools. These changes to be effective Fall Semester 2011.
- Modify Networking Support Certificate (C25340B). Delete NET 225-Routing & Switching I and replace with NOS 110-Operating Systems Concepts. Delete NET 226-Routing & Switching II and replace with NOS 120-Linux/UNIX Single User. In addition substitute NOS 130-Windows Single User for NOS 120-Linux/UNIX Single User. These changes to be effective Fall Semester 2011.

- Modify the Computer Information Technology (A25260) AAS degree and the Web Development and Design Certificate (C2526). Delete WEB 140-Web Development Tools. Add WEB 187-Prog for Mobile Devices. These changes will be effective Spring Semester 2012, but should be entered in the Fall 2011 catalog with a notation stating effective Spring 2012.
- Modify the Computer Information Technology (A25260) and Computer Programming (A25130) AAS degrees. Delete NET 125-Networking Basics as a local prerequisite for SEC 110-Security Concepts. *These* changes to be effective Fall Semester 2011.

Donna Dunn made a motion to accept the proposed changes in each of the five areas as presented. Dixon Boyles seconded the motion. The motion carried.

## Industrial Technology

As acting Division Chair, Wesley Beddard presented items for consideration from the Industrial Technology Division.

- Course Additions
   AUT 110-Intro to Auto Technology
   AUT 186-PC Skillsfor Auto Techs.
   Both courses would be added to the BCCC catalog andavailableon pick lists as course substitutes.
- Prerequisite Additions AUT 183-Engine Performance II as a prerequisite to AUT 281-Advance Engine Performance.

### These additions to be effective Fall Semester 2011.

Dell Enecks made a motion to accept the new course and prerequisite additions. Bryan VanGyzen seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Continuing with proposed Industrial Technology changes, Chairman Beddard entertained a motion to add ISC 112-Industrial Safety to the following programs as indicated:

 Heavy Equipment and Transport Technology/Construction Equipment (A6024B)
Add ISC 112-Industrial Safety to the Major Electives option list.

- Mechanical Engineering Technology (A40320) Add ISC 112-Industrial Safety as an *option* for MAC 113 <sup>2</sup> so that it reads: <sup>2</sup> Students may substitute 6 hours of Co-Op Work Experienceor ISC 112 and 4 hours of Co-Op Work Experience.
- Machinist Diploma (D40320) Add ISC 112-Industrial Safety as a *requirement*, bringing the total hours up to 41.
- Machinist Certificate (C40320) Add ISC 112 as a *requirement*, bringing the total hours up to 17.

### These changes to be effective Fall Semester 2011.

Dixon Boyles made a motion to accept the addition of ISC 112 in each program as presented. Donna Dunn seconded the motion. The motion carried.

### II. Other Items

Chairman Beddard presented information from the Medical Laboratory Technology program for discussion purposes only. He stated that once clinical agreements have been obtained and sites secured, proposed changes will be presented to the Curriculum Committee for an electronic vote.

With no further agenda items Chairman Beddard entertained a motion to adjourn. Harold Smith made a motion to adjourn. Camille Richardson seconded the motion. The motion carried.
