II. Projecting Forward

➢ Recovering & Retaining FTE through Special Project – Sara Singleton offers her assistance with an action plan for FTE recovery. David Crosby reminds the group that Continuing Ed FTE requires 688 contact hours to equal 1 FTE; whereas, it takes 512 contact hours to equal one FTE for curriculum students. More curriculum students are taking just enough classes to qualify for full-time − 12 credit hours which have caused a decline in FTE despite an increase in enrollment.
