

CURRICULUM COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

May 22, 2003

The Curriculum Committee met Thursday, May 22, 2003, at 11:30 a.m. in the Conference Room of Building 1. Wesley Beddard, Gregg Allinson, Dixon Boyles, Clay Carter, Dell Enecks, Kay Walker Hauser, Dorothy Jordan, Doris King, Riley Mills, Dorie Richter, Penny Sermons, and Harold Smith were present. Haywood Broome was present to introduce a new curriculum in Industrial Technology Division. Wesley called the meeting to order and then addressed the agenda as follows:

I. Minutes of March 20, 2003 Meeting

A motion was made by Gregg Allinson and seconded by Dell Enecks to approve the March 20, 2003, Minutes. Motion carried.

- A. Credit Hour Load Policy – Clay Carter made a motion and seconded by Gregg Allinson to replace the first sentence on page 18 under Credit Hour Load Policy of the Catalog with the following statement:

“Students registering for more than 21 credit hours (more than 16 credit hours for summer term) must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher and the permission of their advisor and the Dean of Instruction.”

- B. AAS General Education Requirement for transfer students with a bachelor’s degree from a regionally accredited college – A motion was made by Clay Carter and seconded by Gregg Allinson to insert in the Catalog the following statement on page 19 under Advanced Standing, Transfer Credit from Other Institutions as a fourth paragraph.

“Any transfer student who holds a bachelor’s degree from a regionally accredited college will have satisfied the General Education and Student Success/Orientation requirements for all Associate in Applied Science degree programs.”

After much discussion, the motion carried. (Attachment 1)

- C. Course Deletion in Computer Programming – Kay Walker Hauser presented the recommendation to delete CSC 135, COBOL Programming from the Computer Programming Curriculum for the fall semester 2003. Dixon Boyles made a motion seconded by Riley Mills to accept the deletion as presented. Motion carried. (Attachment 2)

- D. New Curriculum HEATT/Construction Equipment – Haywood Broome presented the new curriculum Heavy Equipment and Transport Technology/Construction Equipment (A6024B) at Beaufort County Community College. A motion was made by Riley Mills and seconded by Dorothy Jordan to accept the new curriculum as presented. Motion carried. (Attachment 3)

E. Proposed Certificate Environmental Science – Wesley Beddard presented the Environmental Science Certificate (C20140). Gregg Allinson made a motion and seconded by Penny Sermons to accept the Environmental Science Certificate. Motion carried. (Attachment 4)
