

CURRICULUM COMMITTEE

**Minutes
February 26, 2008**

The Curriculum Committee met on February 26, 2008, at 3:00 p.m. in the Conference Room of Building 1. Wesley Beddard, Rhunell Boyd, Dixon Boyles, Clay Carter, Donna Dunn, Riley Mills, and Harold Smith were present. Gregg Allinson was absent. Chairman Wesley Beddard called the meeting to order and addressed the agenda as follows.

I. New Business

Chairman Wesley Beddard announced any curriculum changes that are to be effective Fall Semester 2008 should be submitted to Bebe Major by March 17, 2008.

A. Arts and Sciences

1. Dixon Boyles expressed the need to identify General Education Competencies for SACS accreditation. Clay Carter made a motion to accept the identification of General Education Competencies as listed:
Communication Skills, Computational Skills, Critical Thinking Skills, Interpersonal Skills, Technology Skills, and Research Skills. Donna Dunn seconded the motion. The motion carried.
2. Dixon Boyles presented to the group the need for adopting a transfer course substitution form as a means of facilitating transfer courses which meet BCCC's general education core requirements within the spirit of the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement. After much discussion and a few minor adjustments to the form, Dixon Boyles made the motion to adopt the form to facilitate the evaluation of transcripts for transfer credit (see attachment 1). Harold Smith seconded the motion. The motion carried.

B. Industrial Technology

Riley Mills made a motion to delete MAT 223, Applied Calculus from the Electronics Engineering Technology program and the Electrical Engineering Technology program effective Fall 2008. For the Electronics Engineering Technology program this changes the total number of credit hours from 75 to 72, and for the Electrical Engineering Technology program this changes the total number of credit hours from 76 to 73. Rhunell Boyd seconded the motion. The motion carried. MAT 223 is to be deleted from the BCCC catalog.

Clay Carter made a motion to table all other business items on the agenda until the March meeting (date to be announced). Riley Mills seconded the motion. The motion carried.
