#### **Curriculum Committee**

## Minutes July 9, 2007

The Curriculum Committee met on July 9, 2007, at 2:00 p.m. in the Conference Room of Building 1. In seeking an endorsement of the curriculum committee to proceed with the application process of the Agricultural Biotechnology program, Wesley Beddard shared information pertaining to the new program. Startup may possibly be Spring Semester 2008, but most likely will begin Fall Semester 2008. Gregg Allinson made a motion to approve the curriculum application process for the Agricultural Biotechnology program. Dixon Boyles seconded the motion. The motion carried.
